



# HOW TO DETECT A LEAK

---

A simple check can be made by following these steps:

## **TREATED WATER METERS**

**LOOK AT YOUR METER** – Note down the numbers on the **RED** dials.

**DON'T USE ANY WATER** – Inside the house don't use any water, make sure there are no dripping taps.

**WAIT FOR AT LEAST ONE HOUR**

**RELOOK AT YOUR METER** – Any movement on the red dials indicates that you have a leak somewhere in the house.

## **UNTREATED WATER METERS**

**LOOK AT YOUR METER**

**DON'T USE ANY WATER** – Outside the house don't use any water, make sure there are no dripping taps.

**CHECK TO SEE IF THE DIAL IS TURNING** – The low-flow indicator should not be moving. Any movement indicates that you have a leak.

## **IF YOU DETECT A LEAK**

Check for:

- Dripping taps.
- Leaking Cisterns.
- Continual damp patches in the garden.

If you can not find anything consult a plumber for assistance.
